To control Fleas, Ticks and Lice on Dogs and Cats: Dust powder
liberally over the entire body. Rub dust into hair and around the
feet, pads and between the toes so that they are well treated.
Take care not to get the powder in animal's eyes, nose or mouth.
Dust bedding, kennel and sleeping area regularly. Repeat as
needed, but not more often than once weekly. Do not use on pregnant
dogs.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry location. Keep cap closed tightly.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.
