**To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks:** Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), with one gallon of water. Use rubber gloves. Work in well ventilated area. Dip animal in solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.
