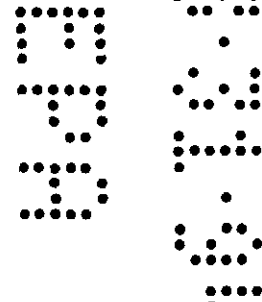
Ear mites usually induce the formation of a dry, dark brown, waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of pets. Ear mites may be detected by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and carefully watching for the movement of tiny white specks away from the exudate. Inflamed, watery or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Ear Mites: Clean ears to remove built-up wax and dirt. While firmly holding pet, fill ear canal with recommended number of drops in each ear. Massage base of ear to insure insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Gently dry ear with a cotton ball, soft cloth, or cotton swab. This solution applied twice monthly will reduce the possibility of ear mite infestation and the accumulation of ear wax. If no improvement is seen after 2 applications, consult a veterinarian.

Body Weight	Dosage
5 to 15 lbs.	4 to 5 drops
15 to 30 lbs.	5 to 10 drops
30 lbs. & over	10 to 15 drops

If condition for which this preparation is used persists or if an irritation develops, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian.

For use with a swabstick: Open packet, remove swabstick. While firmly holding pet, fill ear with liquid from packet. Massage base of ear to insure that insecticidal action penetrates ear wax. Use swabstick to remove as much waxy exudate as possible from the outer ear. **IMPORTANT:** Do not use the swabstick for the ear canal (i.e. Swab part should always be visible!) to avoid damaging the delicate tissue of the ear.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area, away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Human: Not for use on puppies, kittens, or rabbits less than 7 weeks old. For external use only. Do not use for a prolonged period of time. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Wash hands with soap and water after using. Do not apply directly to food or contaminate food or feedstuffs with this product.

Animals: Avoid contact with eyes. If in eyes, flush with water. Do not use on meat or milk producing animals.
