Application Instructions

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING ALPHA 3 ROACH BAIT IN NEW CONSTRUCTION TO CONTROL

COCKROACHES: When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and cabinet voids and areas around utility openings in new and existing construction, apply bait liberally into cracks and crevices. This product may be used in homes, restaurants and other feed and food handling establishments, markets, warehouses, factories, offices, schools, motels, hotels, nursing homes, hospitals, grocery stores, garages, apartment buildings, new constructions, theaters, ships, boats, aircraft, industrial plants, mobile homes, zoos, kennels, military bases, libraries and utilities.

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT, FOOD AND FEED HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences on which food or feed is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREA – APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY: Includes areas for receiving, storing, packing (canning, wrapping, boxing) preparing edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems such as mills, dairies, bakeries, restaurants or anywhere food or feed is stored, processed, prepared or served, Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation) also would be considered a food area. Apply Alpha 3 Roach Bait using a suitable bait applicator, suitable for using the 30gram reservoir such as the Bait Gun. Place applicator tip into cracks and crevices, holes or other openings, points between different construction elements, between equipment and floors, openings leading to wall voids, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housings where roaches may be a problem. Apply small amounts of bait (up to 1/2 gram) per spot.

SERVING AREAS: Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where food may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction into cracks and crevices.

NON – FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, offices, locker rooms, boiler rooms, mop closets, and storage (after canning or bottling) Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where roaches hide or through which they may enter.

ALPHA 3 ROACH BAIT is packaged in a plastic reservoir containing (1 oz.) of bait. Application rate is dependant on the level of infestation and the species to be controlled. Bait can be applied as spots or as a bead in cracks and crevices. The lower application rate should be used for low to moderate infestations or re-treatments and the higher rate for more severe infestations or where the population occurs in inaccessible areas, such as in walls. Bait placements should be at or near harborage or aggregation areas, such as corner, areas of movement or cracks and crevices. Numerous smaller placements will provide faster control than fewer larger spots especially for German cockroach control.

General Information

STIR WELL BEFORE USING

Alpha 3 roach Bait may be used as a spot or crack and crevice treatment for the control of cockroaches, in residential areas and in the non food and non feed areas of institutional, warehousing and commercial establishments, including warehouses, restaurants, food processing plants, supermarkets, hospitals, nursing homes, motels, hotels, schools, laboratories, computer facilities, sewers, aircraft, buses, boats, ships, trains, pet shops, zoos. Non-food and feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories; floor drains ("to sewers") entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage rooms. During follow up visits, inspect bait placements and reapply when necessary. This product may be used in food and feed handling establishments as outlined below.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff. Avoid contamination or ornamental plants.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AND FEED AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT IS NOT PERMITTED.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the bait onto exposed food and feed processing surfaces, or food serving surfaces to avoid contamination. Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods and feeds are exposed. Avoiding treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. Do not apply to surfaces or cracks and crevices, which are routinely washed as bait may be removed by washing. Do not apply Alpha 3 Roach Bait to areas, which have been recently sprayed with insecticide, and do not spray insecticide over bait as it may cause bait to become repellent.
