c. "Warning" is the signal word for this product. Please display this word as prominently as indicated in 40 CFR part 156.10 and change the back panel from "Caution" to "Warning".

- 2.d. Remove "Specimen Label - Insect Repellent Lotion made from MGK Diethyltoluamide" from the label.
- e. Replace "How to Use" with the heading "Directions For Use".
- f. Move the phrase "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" under the heading "Directions For Use".
- g. Add under Hazards to Humans "Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes."
- h. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment similar to the following:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

3. We note and accept the use of the following text which is not required: "Do not use on infants. Not recommended for use on children under age 10."

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
