This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 65723-1."

b. In the First Aid (Practical Treatment) section, replace the phrase "sufficient milk or water" with "large amounts of water." Also replace the statement after the "Note to Physician" heading with, "Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

c. Replace the text after the "Environmental Hazard" heading with the following:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this

product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

d. Replace the first sentence after the "Instructions for Use" heading with, "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

e. In the "Storage" paragraph, in the sentence, "Avoid contaminating...", replace "Avoid" with "Do not".

f. In the "Disposal of Pesticide" paragraph, replace the first two sentences with, "Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous." In the third sentence, replace the words "Inadequate or unsafe" with "Improper".

g. Delete the phrase "CAS No." from above the ingredients statement.

3. For our records, tell us the weight of a tablet.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

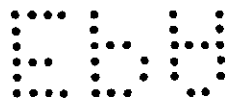
