Keep product dry in tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat, open flames, organic chemicals and sunlight. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard in trash. Waste resulting from the use of this product can be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal site. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous.
