Dear Ms. Hogue:

This is in response to your amended labeling with directions for two added uses.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. In the directions for treatment of food eggs, add a statement that the solution must not be re-used for this purpose.

2. In the directions for treatment of fruits and vegetables, for the final rinse change the word "water" to "potable water" (or "clean water"). Also indicate that this rinse is to occur only immediately prior to packaging.

3. Either delete the "Practical Treatment" section on the back panel, or change it so that it is the same as on the front panel.

4. The Spanish must be (we assume that it is) an accurate translation of the English.

For our records, submit a letter other than a fax copy, on the registrant's company letterhead (or notarized), authorizing you to act as their agent in registration matters with EPA.

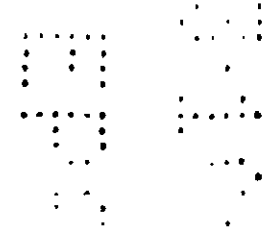
