TO OPERATE: Shake before using. Hold sprayer 18 inches from foliage and spray with circular motion. Direct spray so that upper and lower leaf surfaces are contacted. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat treatment as necessary. When using outdoors, spray when air is still.

Use on the following crops: Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Brussels Sprouts, Celery, Cranberries, Eggplant, Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Kale, Collards, Turnips, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach and Tomatos.

To Control: Asparagus beetles, aphids, leafhoppers, whiteflies, Mexican bean beetles, 12-spotted cucumber beetles, cabbage loopers, cross-striped cabbageworms, stink bugs, green peach aphids, leaftiers, fireworms, blister beetles, Colorado potato beetles, and webworms.

Use on the following ornamentals: African violets, Azaleas, Begonias, Camellias, Dahlias, Dogwood, Roses, Wandering Jew, Asters, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Geraniums, Gladiolus and Marigolds.

To Control: Aphids, flea beetles, leafhoppers and whiteflies.

To kill Gypsy moth caterpillars and adults, adult Japanese beetles and forest tent caterpillars on contact:

On trees and shrubs: Treat trees and shrubs as soon as insects emerge (usually late spring). Treat leaves, branches and tree trunks evenly, making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days as necessary for control.

#### \*\*\*\*\*\*

On roses and in flower gardens: Treat plants and flowers as soon as insects appear. Spray plants and flowers making sure to penetrate dense foliage. Repeat application every 7 days or as necessary for control.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and

pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.
