Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. To apply to face, spray into hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothing. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing.

If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

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
