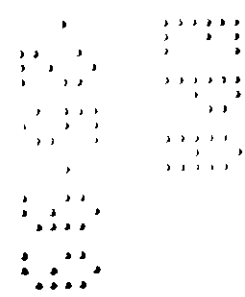

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Apply at the rates of 3.5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. to a maximum of 7 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. when fungus and nematodes are active as recommended by State Agricultural Experiment Stations or State Extension Service Specialists. Repeat fungicide/nematicide application with regular scheduled fertilizer treatment or at 30 to 60 day intervals. Irrigate with 1/4 to 1/2 inch of water within 12 to 24 hours of application.
