RABON[®] Oral Larvicide per hundred pounds of body weight. Animals should not be starved for minerals before initiation of the RABON[®] control TUB program. Place near loafing areas.

If consumption of MLS control TUB is above 1/3 lb. per 1000 lbs of body weight per day, reduce the number of feeding locations.

If consumption is below 1/3 lb per 1000 lbs of body weight per day, increase the number of feeding locations. Start feeding the MLS control TUB early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer and the fall.
