  - 2. Make the following label changes:
    - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, EPA Reg. No.65901-2
    - b. Revise the statement within the directions for use "MINERLIX Fly Control Tub may not be fed to horse intended for human consumption." to the following: "This product is not to be used on horses destined for slaughter."     - c. Remove the box from the section entitled "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS." Directly above the subsection statement, insert the subtitle "Precautionary Statements" In addition, after the subtitle and on a new line, you must insert the signal word "CAUTION". Within the HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" subsection insert the statement "This product may cause skin sensitization reactions in certain individuals." The personal protective equipment section must also be revised. An example of the revised section is as follows:

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Provide one tub per 40 head of cattle. Cattle should consume an average of 2 oz. to 4 oz. of the tub per 1000 LB of body weight per day. This will supply the recommended average intake of 51 mg. RABON Oral Larvicide per hundred pounds of body weight. Animals should not be starved for minerals before initiation of the MINERLIX Fly Control Tub program. Place near loafing areas.

If consumption of MINERALIX Fly Control Tub is above 4 oz. per 1000 LB of body weight per day, reduce the number of feeding locations.

If consumption is below 2 oz. per 1000 LB of body weight per day, increase the number of feeding locations. Start feeding the MINERALIX Fly Control Tub early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding throughout the summer and the fall.

MINERALIX Fly Control Tub may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows.

MINERALIX Fly Control Tub may not be fed to horse intended for human consumption.
