DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

USE RESTRICTIONS

Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs. THIS PRODUCT IS INTENDED FOR INDOOR USE ONLY. Do not use in aircraft cabins. This product is not for use in outdoor residential misting systems. Do not apply this product directly to domestic animals (pets). Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. Wait two (2) hours after application, and then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required. Do not use in food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared and processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. FOR USE IN HOUSEHOLDS, SCHOOLS, WAREHOUSES, OFFICE BUILDINGS, THEATRES, GARAGES, HOTELS, MOTELS, KENNELS TO KILL COCKROACHES: Spray on floors along baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and food storage areas and

suspected entry and hiding places such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, cracks and crevices, etc. TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds) per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Thoroughly ventilate treated area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary. TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators. TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary, DO NOT APPLY THIS PRODUCT DIRECTLY TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS (PETS): Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VANS, SHIPS AND IN TENTS. FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Release 3 feet from any surface, holding dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser about while spraying aids in dispense only for time indicated. Ten seconds of spraying is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10 feet x 10 feet x 10 feet). Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Thoroughly ventilate treated area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL COCKROACHES: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring cockroaches.

Special attention should be paid to cracks, and hidden surfaces under where these pests are suspected of hiding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place that is away from heat or open flame, in an area that is inaccessible to children or pets. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture of incinerate! IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. IF PARTIALLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instrucitons.
