The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the phenothrin RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds) per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Thoroughly ventilate treated area before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators. TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames,

wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT APPLY THIS PRODUCT DIRECTLY TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS (PETS): Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place that is away from heat or open flame, in an area that is inaccessible to children or pets.
