The end-product may only be formulated into polymeric-matrix removable dispensers as described in 40 CFR 180.1124.

The end-product may be used to control the Mediterranean Fruit Fly on infested fruit crops, nut crops and vegetable crops.

FOR USE IN TRAPS AND LURES

This technical-grade product may be used in traps and lures without further registration requirements when it is the only active ingredient in accordance with 40CFR 152.25(b).

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
