APPLY TO MOUND WHEN THE ANTS ARE ACTIVE (WHEN SOIL TEMPERATURE IS GREATER THAN 46 DEGREES F) ADDITIONAL TREATMENT MAY BE NECESSARY IF PRECIPITATION OCCURS WITHIN A 24 HOUR PERIOD OF APPLICATION. REAPPLICATION OR LARGER VOLUMPS OF APPLICATION MAY BE REQUIRED FOR LARGER ANT MOUND.
