

TRUE STOP FIRE ANT INSECTICIDE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. True Stop is for the control of fire ants. SHAKE WELL, then apply as a drench at a diluted rate of 2/3 cup per one gallon of water. Gently pour the solution in and around the base of the mound until the tunnels are exposed. Thoroughly drench the tunnels and surrounding area (8-10 ounces of solution per 4" diameter mound). Apply to the mound when the ants are active (when soil temperature is greater than 46°F). Additional treatment may be necessary if excessive precipitation occurs within 24 hrs. after application. If soil is extremely dry, wet mound and surrounding area with water before treatment. Reapplication may be required for larger ant mounds. Allow 14 days before reapplication.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not get into eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children. Keep from freezing or extreme temperatures. Store between 32°F and 72°F.

Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and puncture before discarding in a sanitary landfill, or incinerate if allowed by state and local authorities. Stay out of the smoke when burning.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. True Stop is toxic to fish. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water.

FIRST AID: Inhalation: Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician if swallowed: Give fluids and seek medical attention. Do not induce vomiting (never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person).

PROTECTIVE MEASURES: It is recommended that glasses, goggles, gloves, or protective clothing be used to prevent eye and prolonged skin contact.
