d. Revise the **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** section to appear as follows:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public water unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in a NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

e. The storage and the disposal instructions should appear together under the heading **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**, preceded by the following statement: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

This product is toxic to both fish and birds. Keep out of contact with any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or the disposal of wastes/ spills.
