STERILIZATION TESTS:
1. **STERILIZATION OF BACTERIAL CULTURES:** 100 ml of bacterial suspension (10⁸ to 10⁹ CFU/ml) in 200 ml of water, treated with 100 ml of 1:25 dilution of ADVANTAGE 256, held at 60°C for 30 minutes, then plated on nutrient agar. No growth observed.
2. **STERILIZATION OF BACTERIAL SPORES:** 100 ml of bacterial suspension (10⁸ to 10⁹ CFU/ml) in 200 ml of water, treated with 100 ml of 1:25 dilution of ADVANTAGE 256, held at 60°C for 30 minutes, then plated on nutrient agar. No growth observed.
3. **STERILIZATION OF BACTERIAL SPORES:** 100 ml of bacterial suspension (10⁸ to 10⁹ CFU/ml) in 200 ml of water, treated with 100 ml of 1:25 dilution of ADVANTAGE 256, held at 60°C for 30 minutes, then plated on nutrient agar. No growth observed.
