

**Hand Sanitizing**—in food handling and meat cutting operations. Rinse and immerse hands in a 1 oz. IODIS per 5 gals. of water solution (25 ppm titratable iodine).

**Retort Cooling Water—For canning Operations**—add 1 oz. IODIS per 5-10 gals. of retort water prior to starting up operation to control slime and odor causing bacteria.

**Poultry Drinking Water Sanitization**—1 oz. IODIS per 10 gallons of drinking water.

**Shoe Bath Sanitizer**—To prevent tracking harmful organisms into animal areas, scrape shoes and place in a 3 oz. per gallon solution of IODIS for 30 seconds prior to entering area.
