Refer to use solution chart when preparing dilutions recommended in the following directions.

Always prepare fresh sanitizing solutions and use them the same day prepared. All sanitizing solutions should contact surfaces at least two minutes prior to rinsing. When circulating sanitizer solutions through CIP systems, allow at least 5 minutes contact.

No potable water rinse is required for sanitizing solutions containing 25 ppm titrateable or less if treated surfaces are thoroughly drained. Titrateable iodine solutions above 25 ppm require rinsing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Storage:** Store only in tightly closed, original container in a secure area inaccessible to children. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
- Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
