### DIRECTION FOR USE

Before sale of any germicide in intra- or interstate commerce, it must be registered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. MYCOCIDIC ACID CONCENTRATE may be used to manufacture germicides and detergent sanitizers that do not require rinsing if applied to well drained food contact surfaces at concentrations not exceeding 25 ppm titratable iodine.

### STORAGE

Store only in tightly closed, original container in a cool secure area. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

### DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
