Dear Mr. Gary Gaumer:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

A. You have cited another product containing glutaraldehyde to support your addition of fogging directions to this label. Thus your directions must be in agreement with that label and meet Agency standards as to acceptable language for fogging.

1. Delete the entire section beginning: "Directions for Fogging: Synergize is recommended..." and ending "with potable water prior to reuse."

2. Add fogging directions to the section "Directions for Use in Poultry Houses" to read exactly as follows:

"Prior to fogging setters or hatchers, food products and packaging must be removed from the room or carefully protected. After cleaning, fog desired areas using one quart per 1000 cubic feet of room area with a product solution containing 0.25 to 1 ounce per gallon of water. Vacate all areas of personnel and poultry and feeds for a minimum of 2 hours after fogging. All food contact surfaces, including feed troughs, automatic feeders, and fountains must be disinfected followed by treatment with soap and water or detergent and rinsed with potable water before reuse."

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
Note: The fog generated is irritating to the eyes, skin and mucous membranes. Under no circumstances should a room or building be entered by anyone within two hours of the actual fogging. If the building must be entered, then the individuals entering the building must wear a self-contained respirator approved by NIOSH/MSHA, goggles, long sleeves and long pants.

FOGGING IS TO BE USED AS AN ADJUNCT TO ACCEPTABLE MANUAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTION OF ROOM AND MACHINE SURFACES."

3. These are the only changes which have been accepted for this label at this time.
4. Submit two (2) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
