
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You must submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) and make the following changes. The certified limits for the inert ingredient, hydriodic acid, are not acceptable. The concentration or strength of the hydriodic acid used in 57%, therefore, the nominal concentration (N) of this inert ingredient is 5.6%. All upper and lower limits must be based on the (N) of either an active or inert ingredient. The correct upper limit for hydriodic acid is 5.9% while the lower limit is 5.3%. The percent weight of 9.8 given in item 13b for the hydriodic acid solution is correct and should not be changed. Correction of the certified limits are only required.

The separate supplier name and address list is an official part of the CSF and as such, must be marked with a page number e.g., page 2 or 2 while the first page would be numbered page 1 of 2.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
