Dear Ms. Stout:

The revised product labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's conditions as enumerated in this letter below and submit one copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Delete the User Safety Recommendations box and its contents. Add the following in the precautionary statement after the Caution signal word (marked with an * on page 1): "Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."
2. Insert the sentence "Keep the public off treated areas until the treated area is dry." to the Direction for Use section of the label.
3. Replace the First Aid section with the following:

First Aid

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.


If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

NOTE: retain the "Note to Physician" section after the above added text.

The conditions of paragraph 5 of the June 2000 Memorandum of Agreement apply to this label amendment, specifically this amended label is effective December 1, 2000. Failure to comply with any of the conditions of registration set forth in Paragraph 10 of the MOA shall be grounds for cancellation of the affected registration(s) under FIFRA section 6(e). Submit one copy of the revised final printed label before releasing the product for shipment. If the conditions enumerated above are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e).

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS
