If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA, Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

WARNING

Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service Specialist for specific information, as the timing and number of applications needed will vary with local conditions.

AVOCADO: Scab (spot anthracnose) (Sphaceloma) - FOR USE IN FLORIDA ONLY - 3-lbs. Apply 6 pounds of Folpet 50-W per acre in sufficient water for thorough coverage (up to 1000 gallons of finished spray per acre). Apply to the foliage when bloom buds begin to swell in very susceptible varieties, or during late bloom when some fruit has set in the slight and moderately susceptible varieties. Repeat at 2 week intervals or as needed. Do not exceed 7 applications per season. Do not apply more than 42 pounds of Folpet 50-W per acre per year. Do not make applications within 7 months of harvest.

REENTRY STATEMENT

Do not enter treated areas for 24-hours after application unless wearing long sleeved shirt, long pants, and a dust mask or similar protection against particle inhalation.

Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

WORKER PROTECTION

Wear goggles or face shield, long sleeved shirt and long pants when mixing, loading and applying this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse. A dust mask or similar protection against particle inhalation must be worn when mixing, loading and applying this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage - Store in a cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat.

Container Disposal - Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Pesticide Disposal - Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

COMPATIBILITY

FOLPET 50-W may be combined with most commonly used insecticides, adjuvants and fungicides. Fungicidal activity of FOLPET 50-W is reduced if combined with strongly alkaline materials such as hydrated lime. This material should not be used in combination with or closely following oil sprays.

Do not combine wettable powders with emulsifiable liquids in the same spray tank unless previous use of the materials being combined has proved them to be physically compatible.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Pour required amount of this material onto surface of water in a nearly-filled spray tank ~~filled with the final desired spray volume~~, or pre-mix ~~required amount of material~~ in a bucket half-filled with water and pour mixture through screen into nearly-a-filled spray tank ~~filled with the final desired spray volume~~. Add balance of water to fill tank ~~to final volume desired~~. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations. Do not allow mixture to stand.
