Pour required amount of this material onto surface of water in a spray tank 2/3 filled with the final desired spray volume, or pre-mix required amount of material in a bucket half-filled with water and pour mixture through screen into a spray tank 2/3 filled with the final desired spray volume. Add balance of water to find tank to final volume desired. Keep agitator running during filling and spraying operations. Do not allow mixture to stand

Apply to the foliage when bloom buds begin to swell in very susceptible varieties or during late bloom when some fruit has set in the slight and moderately susceptible varieties. Repeat at 2 week intervals or as needed. Do not exceed 5 applications per season. Do not apply more than 42 pounds of FOLPAN 50W per acre per year. Do not make applications within 7 days of harvest.
