ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Propiconazole; 1-[[2-(2,4-dichlorophenyl)-4-propyl-1,3-dioxolan-2-yl]methyl]-1H-1,2,4-triazole 93.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS: 7.0%
TOTAL 100.0%

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN CAUTION

FIRST AID

- IF IN EYES:**
 - Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
 - Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Only for formulation into a fungicide for the following sites of use: celery, cereals (barley, oats, rye, wheat), corn, grasses for seed, peanuts, pecans, pineapples, rice, sap stain control, stone fruit, sugarcane, turf, and ornamentals, wood treatment.
2. Uses for which U.S. EPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and
3. Uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with U.S. EPA requirements.
