READ AND FOLLOW THE LABEL DIRECTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both alkaline and acid pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

This product will control almost all of the green and blue-green algae commonly occurring in swimming pool situations. Phormidium inudatum commonly called Black Algae, will be controlled with this product some scrubbing may be required to loosen the killed algae.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply the recommended rate of this product at the end of the day when the pool is empty. After treatment, surfaces should be scrubbed to dislodge killed algae and the pool should be vacuumed to remove dead or settle algae. In addition to the treatment, algae occurring in deep cracks or crevices may require additional scrubbing and vacuuming.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE

Pools having visible algae: Add an initial dose of 16-24 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth: Additions of 6-10 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after the initial treatment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin damage. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

(First Aid)
