DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: Children and pets should not be in treatment area until after application is completed. Do not treat pets with this product. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ornamental plants.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

- CARPETS:**
1. Vacuum all carpeted areas thoroughly and dispose of vacuum bag.
 2. Apply to dry carpet only.
 3. Apply product directly onto carpets, at the rate of 1 pound per 200 sq. feet. (16mg/sq in). pay special attention to where pets sleep and frequent.
 4. Work product to the base of the carpet pile with a household broom or rug rake. (Product must fall to the base of the carpet pile to be effective).
 5. Visible product remaining after application must be removed by further grooming or by vacuuming.

Allow two to five weeks for maximum flea control.

Note: If a very high adult flea population exists in the home, you may want to apply a pesticide designed to kill adult fleas before using this product. Before you apply Flea Magic carpets must be dry.

UPHOLSTERY: Remove loose cushions. Apply with approved applicator along creases and into corners and furniture wells. Do not apply to exposed fabric.

Any visible product after application must be removed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do NOT reuse container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerator, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
