Your suppliers of DEET are no longer claiming that their products are 100 percent active. Therefore to maintain the 20 percent claim on your label you must adjust the amount of your suppliers product that goes into your product. The various suppliers of DEET are claiming a different active percentage, therefore the amount will vary depending on which supplier you use. Submit a revised Confidential Statement Of Formula.
