- Repels mosquitoes that may carry diseases

2. Add the following statement to the Directions for Use":

•"Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin."

3. "The "Precautionary Statements" should be revised to read as follows: Causes moderate eye irritation,. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco".
