It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.

For best results, spread evenly and completely over all exposed skin. Apply to hand for application to face and neck. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Repeat application as necessary. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to excessively sunburned skin.
