On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 66306-4".
  - b. Remove "up to 10 hours" from marketing claim, since it may mislead the user to believe that the repellent effect lasts this long.
  - c. To comply with the DEET Label Improvement Program (see PR Notice 91-4) add the statement, "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you." after "... Poison Control Center."

- d. Remove the statement "long lasting" from the third paragraph on the back panel.
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
4. Submit your CSF with the following changes:
  - a. Place the percentage by weight of "other isomers" under column 13b in parentheses.
  - b. Correct the chemical names for the two sunscreens and the CAS registry number for the emulsifier identified in Confidential Appendix A (enclosed).
5. Storage stability test for one year under ambient warehouse conditions must be conducted on the commercially packaged product. The test results need not be submitted to EPA unless one or more of the deficiencies cited in PR Notice 92-5 has been noted. However, the data should be available whenever EPA may request it.
6. Series 63-20 (Corrosion Characteristics): This study should be conducted on the commercially packaged product in conjunction with the one year storage stability tests.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.



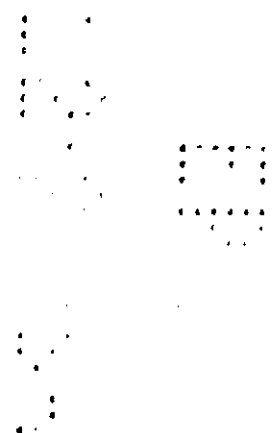
