  - b. In the first sentence on page 2 of the label, change "an" to read "and".
3. Delete the DEET supplier, Hoechst Celanese Corp., EPA Reg. No. 8340-39, from the basic Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). Use of this product will not meet the certified limits stated on the basic CSF for the subject product because this supplier's product label states the concentration of DEET as 95% (see comments below).
4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.



Sunsect® Camo Face Paint is a camouflage makeup specially formulated to repel mosquitos, ticks, chiggers, deer flies, stable flies, black flies, fleas and gnats on exposed skin surfaces.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Read and follow all directions and precautions on this product label.** Apply to hand for application to face and neck. Do not apply to children's hands. Do not allow children to handle this product. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Wipe hands after applying. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning to indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Safe to use on cotton and wool. Do not apply to synthetic fabrics other than nylon or polyester. May damage furniture finishes, plastics, linoleum, painted surfaces and watch crystals.
