

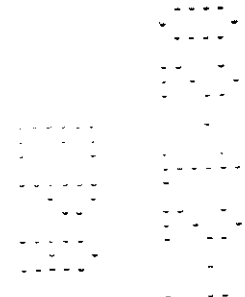

Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. If used on face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly on face. Wipe hands after applying. When using on children, apply to your own hands and then put it on child. To apply to clothing, spray shirts, socks and hat. For ticks, also spray pant cuffs, socks and around opening in outer clothing. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over application of this product. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. After returning to indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Safe to use on cotton and wool. Do not apply to synthetic fabrics other than nylon or polyester. May damage furniture finishes, plastics, linoleum, painted surfaces and watch crystals.
