- 2. Make the following change to the label:
 - a. Change the product registration number to "EPA Reg. No. 66303-15"
 - b. Make the following label revisions:
 - 1. Labeling Claims section comment(s):
 - Delete the labeling claim, "Repels mosquitoes that may carry diseases."
 - 2. Revise the Ingredient Statement section to appear as follows:

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: 10.0% OTHER INGREDIENTS: 90.0% Total 100.0%

- 3. Labeling Claims section, label page 2 of 4, comment(s):
 - In general, please delete all (FDA) statements regarding premature aging and wrinkling from this label as these are implied safety claims.
 - Revise page 2 of 4 of your recently submitted (January 5, 2007) revised label as follows:
 - Paragraph 2, 2nd sentence, delete the words "patented formula" and "a continuous long lasting shield."
 - Paragraph 2, last sentence, delete the words "and natural" and "and natural."
 - Paragraph 2, last sentence, insert the word "and" immediately following the words "non-greasy."
 - Paragraph 3, 3rd sentence, delete the word "children's."
 - Paragraph 4, last sentence, delete the words "and natural."
 - Paragraph 4, last sentence, insert the word "and" immediately following the words "non-greasy."
- 4. Directions for Use section comment(s):
 - Insert a new subtitle directly following the statement starting with "Read and follow...." to read as follows: "USE PRECAUTIONS."
- 5. Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section comment(s):
 - Delete the existing precautionary statement and add the following general statement to appear as paragraph #1 in the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing."

- 6. Relocate the existing "If Swallowed" subsection to appear as the 1st line in the First Aid section.
- 7. Revise the last statement in the First Aid section of this label as follows:
 - In the 2nd sentence, delete the words "For additional information" and replace with "You may also."
 - Insert the words "for emergency medical treatment information" at the end of the 2nd sentence.
 - An additional 800 number is acceptable at the end of the First Aid section, provided that number is available 24 hours per day, 7 days a week. 1
- 8. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL section, the subsection currently listed as "STORAGE" should be changed to "PESTICIDE STORAGE."
- 9. Add the following new subsection immediately following the existing "STORAGE" subsection as follows: "PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility."
- 10. The existing subsection currently listed as "DISPOSAL" should be changed to "CONTAINER DISPOSAL."
- 11. Data deficiencies were identified for storage stability and corrosion characteristics in the product chemistry review for this product. Therefore, Iguana is obligated to submit a One Year Storage Stability (830.6317) study and a Corrosion Characteristics (830.6320) study on this product in support of this registration within one (1) year from the date of this registration.
- 3. Submit two (2) copies of the revised final printed label for the record before the product is released for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
