The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Update and organize the "STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" so that the most severe routes of exposure as demonstrated by the toxicity category classification are listed first (i.e.IF IN EYES, IF ON SKIN, IF INHALED, and IF SWALLOWED).
- 2. Update the eye statement to read: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact physician, Poison Control Center, or emergency clinic before inducing vomiting. Give water or milk to drink and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If medical advice cannot be obtained, take person and a copy of the label or technical bulletin to the nearest emergency treatment facility.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### DANGER

Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May cause allergic skin reactions. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Avoid inhalation of dust. Remove and separately launder clothing before reuse.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

## AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protection equipment (PPE), notification to workers, and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 4 days.

Exception: For the last 48 hours of the REI, workers may enter the treated area to perform hand labor or other tasks involving contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil or water, without time limit, if they wear the early entry PPE listed below.

CAPTAN Methoxychlor 65-10 Seed Protectant is a special formulation for the control of seed rot and damping-off diseases on germinating seeds and seedlings and for control of kernel smut of sorghum, as well as reduction in losses from Cadelle, Rice Weevil, Confused Flour Beetle, Angoumois Grain Moth and Indian Meal Moth during preplanting storage of clean seed.

Slurry Treatment: Mix with water in slurry tank and apply with slurry of misty-type treater, using appropriate settings to apply recommended rates.

Do not feed treated seed to animals. Do not use treated seed for human consumption. Seed treated with CAPTAN Methoxychlor 65-10 Seed Protectant, sold or shipped as feed or foodstuffs may be considered adulterated under state and federal laws. Treated seed must be labeled as follows: "TREATED SEED. DO NOT USE FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL."
