Amendment - To comply with PR Notice 91-2 Your submission dated February 18, 1998.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Change the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT to read, "FIRST AID".
 - 2. Change the FIRST AID statements to read:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

(The above changes must be made to comply with PR Notice 2000-€ by October 1, 2001.)

- 3. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS MUST READ: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed of inhaled. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust. May cause allergic skin reaction.
- 4. Under PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS, PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT change "Waterproof gloves" to read "Chemical Resistant Gloves" (such as polyethylene or polyvinyl). Also add, "Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are listed below. If you want more options, follow the instructions for category selection chart.
- 5. Under AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS change "Waterproof gloves" to read "Chemical Resistant Gloves (such as polyethylene or polyvinyl chloride).

The new basic formulation dated January 30, 2000 is acceptable and supersedes all previously accepted CSFs. A copy of your new CSF has been inserted into the file for this product.

Submit one (1) copy of the revised final label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICE TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes and see a doctor. Hold evelids open and flush with a steady gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Contact-Call a physician, or Poison Control Center, or emergency clinic before inducing vomiting. Give water or milk to drinkDrink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or by administering syrup of ipecae. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If medical advice cannot be obtained, take person and a copy of the label or technical bulletin to the nearest emergency treatment facility. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. If a skin rash develops, see a doctor. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove person from exposure area. Move victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

User Safety Recommendations

Users should:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protection equipment (PPE), notification to workers, and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 4 days.

DIRECTIONS

ORNAMENTALS: ROSES – Black Spot. CARNATIONS – Rust and Leaf Spot. CHRYSANTHEMUMS – Flower Blight – Apply at first sign of disease to give even coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as necessary.

POTATOES: (Seed Pieces): Damp Off – Dust at 7½ ounces per bushel cut seed pieces (12 oz. or ¾ lb. to 100 lbs. cut seed pieces). Apply in convenient container or by duster attachment over belt. Cut pieces should be treated within 6 hours of cutting. If planting is to be delayed more than 1 or 2 days the treated pieces should be stored for 2 days in open crates before bagging. Do not use treated seed for food or feed purposes.

SOIL AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENT: Preplanting for Damp Off and Root Rot Diseases of Seedling or Transplants of Roses (and other shrubs and trees), Many Flowers and Lawn Seedbeds $-1\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (50 to 60 lbs. per acre). Work into upper 3 to 4 inches of soil before planting. Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of captan. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

STOCK: Botrytis Rot – Use 40 to 50 lbs. per acre. Apply when disease appears. Repeat at weekly intervals as needed.

TURF, LAWN: Brown Patch, Leaf Spot, Damp Off, Root Rot – Use 1 to 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Treat before infection occurs. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals throughout summer.

COMPATIBILITY: Do not use this product on foliage closely following oil sprays.

Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift to food, forage or other plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not store or transport near feed or food. Store in cool, dry place. Protect from excessive heat. For help with any spill, leak, fire or exposure involving this material, call day or night (800) 424-9300.
