This product is for manufacturing use for the production of end-use pesticide products for disease control in almonds, bushberries, juneberries, lignonberries, salal, caneberries, cilantro, cucumber, fruiting vegetables, ginseng, grapes, kiwi, leafy greens (except spinach), pear, oriental pear, pomegranate, pistachios, stone fruit, strawberries and ornamentals;
2. Uses for which US EPA has Accepted the Required Data and or Citations of Data that the Formulator has Submitted in Support of Registration; and
3. Uses for Experimental Purposes that are in compliance with US EPA Requirements.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a dry place away from excessive heat. Do not store near food or feed. Store in original container only.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Completely empty container by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into manufacturing equipment. Offer for recycling if available or dispose of container in a sanitary landfill.

Deleted: DISPOSAL

Deleted: Refillable container. Refill this container with this pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the seller. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into manufacturing equipment. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water.
