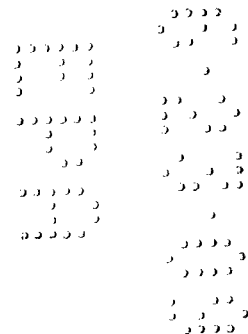

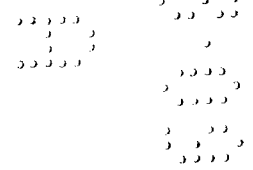
**DANGER**
