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3. The stamped approved label may not be reprinted. Currently missing from the front panel of the label are an ingredient statement (which contains the names and percentages by weight of each active ingredient and the total percentage weight of all inert ingredients), and the signal word and associated precautionary labeling. Elsewhere on the label you must have a section titled "Directions for use", a standard disposal statement, and a net contents statement.

If a new label is printed, submit five final printed labels for our files.

4. For subsequent printing of your labels, the EPA Registration Number shall read, "EPA Reg. No. 66551-3."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your subsequent release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


