The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

# **Proposed Amendment**:

Minor label change to remove "subflooring" from the "Recommended for" section.

## **Label Comments:**

Revise the label as follows per the RED for Copper Naphthenate:

1. The Environmental Hazards section must read:

This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates, shrimps, and oysters/clams. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a national Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.


