

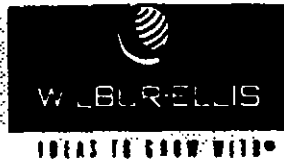

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

WARNING

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds or public water. GENERAL INFORMATION

NU-FLOW D is recommended for use at time of planting as a supplemental seed treatment to protect against seed/seedling rots, damping off and soreshin (caused by Rhizoctonia, Pythium), which impair good seed germination and seedling development of cotton and beans. NU-FLOW D is a ready-to-use flowable designed to be pumped or poured directly into the seed treaters.

NOTE: Federal Law requires that bags containing treated seed shall be labeled with the following information: "This seed has been treated with WILBUR-ELLIS NU-FLOW D fungicide. Do not use treated seed for food, feed or oil purposes. In California, do not graze plants grown from treated seed. In other areas, do not graze treated beans within 45 days of planting."

The purchaser of this product is responsible for insuring that seed treated with this product are adequately dyed with a suitable color to prevent its accidental use as food for man or feed for animals. Refer to 21 CFR, Part 2.25. Any dye added must be cleared for use under 40 CFR, Part 180.1001.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

In California, apply only with closed system equipment.

COTTON and BEANS —

Supplemental Seed Treatment:

Apply NU-FLOW D at the rate of 5.3 to 17.6 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of acid-delinted, reginned, or fuzzy cotton seed (in California use a minimum of 11.4 fl. oz. per 100 lbs.), 7 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of beans.

Use only higher rates under conditions of high pest pressure. Lower rates may give reduced efficiency.

NU-FLOW D may be diluted with water provided the recommended amount of product is applied.

Include an approved dye during treatment at rates recommended by the dyemaker.

Do not use in a manner that will contaminate feed or foodstuffs
