On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 66617-1."
3. Based on data in our files, the claims for minimal protection time under the Guidelines have been accepted. However, as a condition of registration, you are required to submit field test results from testing conducted in the U.S.

Within one year of receipt of this letter, you must submit the field test results. In order to be acceptable, the field testing must be characterized by the following points.

UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

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a) Provide a minimum of 2 hours protection time against mosquitoes based upon first confirmed bite field tests, depending upon the biting pressure evidenced in the testing;

b) Mosquitoes inflicting bites must be captured and identified to genus and preferably to species;

c) Field tests must include an untreated control and positive control for comparison purposes;

d) Data must indicate a minimum protection time of 3 hours based upon first confirmed bite field tests with biting flies or the product may be registered for repelling biting flies if it provides 1 - 3 hours of protection, but the duration of the protection must be stated on the label as "1 - 3 hours protection";

e) Biting flies inflicting bites must be captured and identified to genus; and

f) Biting pressure (presence of mosquitoes and/or biting flies in the area where testing is being conducted) must be confirmed for each test session.

Testing must be conducted in the presence of insects ready to bite. If the product fails to protect for a minimum of 2 hours against mosquitoes or a minimum of 1 hour against biting flies, you must report the level of pest population and any factors which you believe to be responsible for failure of the product to perform according to label claims and directions.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

NOTICE TO CONSUMERS: All three active ingredients in BUGCHASER's insect repellent strips are registered for use in foodhandling establishments.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR ANKLE OR WRISTBAND USE: Remove BUGCHASER INSECT REPELLENT STRIP from reusable barrier bag and place around ankle or wrist 10 minutes before going outside. Snap the ends together for a comfortable fit. Replacement with a fresh strip every 3 hours may be needed to maintain satisfactory repellency against mosquitos and houseflies. Return to reusable barrier bag when not in use to prolong life of product. If skin irritation is observed, discontinue use.

FOR USE AS AN INSECT REPELLENT STRIP: The BUGCHASER INSECT REPELLENT STRIP can be placed anywhere on your clothing or headgear 10 minutes before going outdoors. The strip also can be hung up or placed anywhere indoors or outdoors where mosquitos and flies are attracted and BUGCHASER protection is desired. Useful locations are in garbage cans, closets, kitchen cabinets, drawers, and other enclosures. Replace with a fresh strip when the fragrance dissipates. Replacement with a fresh strip may be needed every 3 hours to maintain satisfactory repellency.
