

After use, clean it with a damp rag, refold the tablecloth when dry, and seal it in its package to retain repellency against insects for the next use. After useful fragrance and repellency disappear, the tablecloth can be replaced by a new one, or it can continue to be kept in use as a non-repellent table covering or picnic blanket.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: To maximize repellency life, store the tablecloth sealed in its original package. Disposal: Securely wrap the original container and tablecloth in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
