DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Terminator Plus may be used in homes, restaurants and other food and food handling establishments, warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yachts, kennels, military bases, libraries, utilities and sewers.

DOMESTIC (HOMEOWNER USE) FLEAS

Use Restrictions: Apply only when children and pets do not have access to treated areas and feed and foodstuffs.

Application Directions for Flea Control: Apply directly on carpets where pets frequent. Work 1 lb. per 100 square feet. Work powder deep into fibers and mat. Any powder not brushed into carpet fibers or vacuumed. Allow powder to remain for a period of 24 hours for control in carpets. Reapply if necessary.

DOMESTIC (HOMEOWNER USE)

COCKROACHES, ANTS AND SILVERFISH

Use Restrictions: Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contact with food, refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into openings, electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of cabinets, all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chest of drawers, drawer wells. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices. Reapply as necessary.

NON-DOMESTIC USE (NONEDIBLE PRODUCT AREAS ONLY)

Use Restrictions: Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use in food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or served while food is exposed.

Directions for Applying in New and Existing Construction to Control Cockroaches: Apply to wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction, dust collection equipment.

Directions for Applying in Sewers and Manhole Cavities: Apply this product at a rate of 1 lb. per sq. ft. using portable blowers or air pressure tanks.

Directions for Applying as a Mop Solution to Control Cockroaches

Mixing and Application Directions: Add 1 cup of powder to each gallon of rinsing water. Make only enough for each application. Supplemental treatment only. Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Places other than private residences in which food or feed is held, processed, prepared or stored.

1. FOOD AREAS (INCLUDING SERVING AREAS)

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing), processing, enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Also includes some food processing areas.

SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, but not where food is prepared. These areas are considered **FOOD AREAS** when food is exposed and the facility is used for food service. Follow application directions in this section. If food is not exposed and facility is used for food service, follow directions under **NONFOOD SERVING AREAS** below.

Use Restrictions: **FOOD AREA** application is limited to **CRACK AND CREVICE** applications to other areas are not permitted.

Application Directions: Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using suitable equipment capable of applying insecticides directly into cracks and crevices. In new construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces, bases, conduits, motor housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or into food processing areas. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

2. NONFOOD AREAS (INCLUDING SOME SERVING AREAS)

Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer), entries and vestibules, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling) areas.

SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, but not where food is prepared. These areas are considered **NONFOOD AREAS** when food is not exposed and the facility is used for food service. Follow application directions in this section. If food is exposed and the facility is used for food service, follow directions under **FOOD SERVING AREAS**.

Application Directions: Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food.

OTHER NONFOOD AREAS
Application Directions: Apply to baseboards areas, around water pipes, surfaces of tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Store in a dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper or plastic.
