DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions. Terminator Plus may be used in homes, restaurants and other food and food warehouses, factories, offices, hotels, motels, hospitals, nursing homes, garages, new construction, industrial plants, theaters, ships, boats, trains, trucks, yards, kennels, military and naval facilities, utilities and sewers.

DOMESTIC (HOMEOWNER USE) FLEA CONTROL

Use Restrictions: Apply only when children and pets do not have access to feed and foodstuffs.

Application Directions for Flea Control: Apply directly on carpets where pet feces are present. Work powder deep into fibers and mat. Any powder brushed into carpet fibers or vacuumed. Allow powder to remain for a period of 24 hours. Reapply if necessary.

DOMESTIC (HOMEOWNER USE) COCKROACHES, ANTS AND SILVERFISH

Use Restrictions: Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contact with food.

Application Directions for Cockroach, Ant and Silverfish Control: Apply powder to refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs; into electrical conduits, and in cracks and crevices along baseboards and corners of all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and drawers. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices.

NON-DOMESTIC USE (NONEDIBLE PRODUCT AREAS ONLY)

Use Restrictions: Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use in food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or served.

Directions for Applying in New and Existing Construction to Control Cockroaches: Apply powder to wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction.

Directions for Applying in Sewers and Manhole Cavities: Apply this product to sewer and manhole cavities using portable blowers or air pressure tanks.

Directions for Applying as a Mop Solution to Control Cockroaches

Mixing and Application Directions: Add 1 cup of powder to each gallon of water. Make only enough for each application. Supplemental treatment only. Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Do not use in other than permanent residences in which food or feed is held, processed, prepared, stored, transported, or distributed.

1. FOOD AREAS (INCLUDING SERVING AREAS)

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, brining, etc.), processing, and distribution (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Also includes areas for food preparation.

FOOD SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, bars, etc. These areas are considered FOOD AREAS when food is exposed and the facility is used for food service. Follow application directions in this section. If food is not exposed and facility is not used for food service, follow application directions under OTHER SERVING AREAS below.

Use Restrictions: FOOD AREA application is limited to CRACK AND CREVICE treatments to other areas are not permitted.

Application Directions: Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Use equipment capable of applying insecticides directly into cracks and crevices in construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hatches, electrical meter housing and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches are present. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

2. NON-FOOD AREAS (INCLUDING SOME SERVING AREAS)

Includes garage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer), entries and vestibules, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling) AREAS.

SERVING AREAS are facilities where food is served, such as dining rooms, bars, etc. These areas are considered NON-FOOD AREAS when food is not exposed and the facility is not used for food service. Follow application directions in this section. If food is exposed and the facility is used for food service, follow application directions under FOOD SERVING AREAS.

Application Directions: Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, door frames, etc. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food.

Application Directions: Apply to baseboards areas, around water pipes, stoves, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may travel.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
