Repeat applications as necessary.

For control of Gnat, Puddle, Sandfly apply at the following rate: Marshlands, margins of streams, intertidal zones of sandy beaches 5 to 10 lbs. per acre. Apply uniformly by ground or air equipment. Repeat application as necessary.
